The Mission Possible & Really Wild Day

Event Information (FAQ's)

When and where will the Really Wild Day take place?

The Really Wild Day, kindly sponsored by Butterfield Bank, is being held on Sunday 12 May 2019 at Jersey Zoo in Trinity. The zoo opens at 9:00 with the Really Wild Day starting at 10:00 and continuing until 17:30.

When and where will the Mission Possible take place?

The Mission Possible is being held at Jersey Zoo on Sunday 12 May 2019 from 10:00 until 15:00.

Do I need to bring anything with me for the day?

Yes – just your email confirmation of your ticket for either the Mission Possible or the Really Wild Day. These should be handed to staff at the Jersey Zoo Visitor Centre. The Really Wild Day will have stalls, food and entertainment and all your needs should be met – apart from of course the usual weather concerns! So please bring sun-cream or waterproofs depending upon the day. Also, if you want to partake in the wet and muddy parts of the Really Wild Day please bring a change of clothes or a towel.

Are there any winners in the Mission Possible?

The Mission Possible is more about taking part than winning and as such we believe that everyone who takes part is a winner! There is however a little activity for those people that want to motivate themselves to meander around the course with a purpose. Upon arrival at Jersey Zoo, you can collect your Mission Possible spy pad from the spy headquarters at the manor house courtyard. Hand in your completed spy pad to mission control where you will be in with a chance to win a photo with none other than Henry Cavill!

Is there a cut-off time?

No. You can take your time on Mission Possible and enjoy your exploration of Jersey Zoo, however if you wish your spy pad to be eligible in the winning draw, you will need to hand it to a member of the Appleby team by 15:00. The photo with Henry Cavill for the winner of the draw is likely to take place at approximately 16:30 at the Durrell Discovery Centre.

Can I take part in the Mission with my children?

Yes of course! The more the merrier. Buggies are welcomed and so are wheelchairs. Unfortunately scooters, bikes, skateboards and all other wheeled devices are not allowed. Children under the age of 3 go free; all other children require a ticket, which can be purchased online – [click here](#)

Can I bring along my dog to stroll with me?

No. Pets are not allowed in Jersey Zoo.

When will the prize be given out?

The Mission Possible prize is a photo with Henry Cavill and will take place at approximately 16:30 within Jersey Zoo. The successful winner will be notified by telephone, which we will have taken from your completed spy pad at approximately 15:00.

My family and/or friends are taking part in the Durrell Challenge 13km race, how will I meet them?

All runners finish within the grounds at Jersey Zoo, which is open from 9:00 for spectators to come in and watch their loved ones cross the finish line.

What parking facilities are available at Jersey Zoo?

Parking is available at Jersey Zoo for a small donation (suggested £3), however parking is limited and we do suggest people car pool if possible. Additional parking is available at the RJA & HS where we have a Park and Ride Scheme that shall be in operation from 10:30 until 18:00 at a cost of £2/car.

- **Liberty Bus** shall be running its normal Sunday service on the Number 3 and Number 23 routes. Please click the following link to view the schedule. <http://m.libertybus.je/Timetables>
- **Shuttle Bus** Jersey Zoo shall be operating a 39 seat shuttle bus departing from Liberation Station every hour from 10:35 to 15:35 and returning from Jersey Zoo to Liberation Station at 11:00, 12:00, 13:00, 14:00, 15:00 and 16:00. Tickets for those attending the Mission Possible and Really Wild Day cost £2 each way. This scheduled service is subject to traffic conditions on the day.
- **Taxi** access is right outside the zoo's Visitor Centre.
